Please do not allow travelers to touch, feed, ride or take selfies with wild animals.

Help us protect our wildlife! Learn more at <u>Impact.ttc.com</u> All wildlife experiences across The Travel Corporation (TTC) and its family of brands must adhere to our Animal Welfare Policy, which is based on the Five Domains of Animal Welfare.

NUTRITION: Animals must have access to sufficient, balanced, varied and clean food and water.

ENVIRONMENT: Animals must have a comfortable environment in order for them to thrive, this includes appropriate: temperature, substrate, space, air, odor, noise and predictability.

HEALTH: Animals must be in good health, have an absence of disease, injury, impairment and a good fitness level.

BEHAVIOUR: Animals must be provided varied, novel and engaging environmental challenges through sensory inputs, exploration, foraging, bonding, playing, retreating.

MENTAL OR AFFECTIVE STATE: By presenting positive situations in the previous four functional domains, the mental state of the animal should benefit from predominantly positive states, such as pleasure, comfort or vitality, while reducing negative states such as fear, frustration, hunger, pain or boredom.
